<b>Acer circinatum 'Pacific Fire'</b> Oregon Vine Maple DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; bushy upright habit to about 12' tall by 8' wide; scarlet winter stems; spring foliage open lime-green before turning brilliant orange-yellow in fall; red samaras in late spring; native to moist wooded sites in the woods of the Pacific Northwest, but will handle sun & dryer soils (Schmidt) Zones 6 - 7			3g

<b>Acer griseum</b> Paperbark Maple DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; inconspicuous yellowish spring flower yields approx. 2" long samaras; showy exfoliating bark is usually cinnamon to orange; green summer foliage usually turns shades of red in the fall; variable growth & branching reaching to about 25' tall & wide; usually a single trunk for 3' to 6'; tolerates alkaline & clay soil; not drought tolerant; locate in full sun to partial shade (preferred) & most soils with good to moderate drainage; PHS Gold Metal; Chinese native; Zones 4 - 8		4 - 5'	B&B

<b>Acer palmatum 'Alpine Sunrise'</b> Dwarf Red Japanese Maple DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; inconspicuous red & white flowers in spring; small winged samaras appear in late spring & mature in fall; bright red foliage emerges in spring which transitions to maroon by summer then scarlet in the fall; dwarf bushy habit to about 4' tall & wide in 10 years; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; witches broom; Japanese native (McCaffrey) Zones 5 - 8			3g	

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<b>Acer palmatum 'Amagi shigure'</b> Compact Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; bright pink reticulated foliage emerges in spring with darker venation; as the leaves mature they get darker red before becoming more purple in summer - still with darker veins; spectacular orange shades appear in fall; compact habit to 6' tall by 3' wide in 10 years; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; there is also a dwarf green leafed variety with the same name; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 8</i>			7g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Amber Ghost'</b> Variegated Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; new foliage emerges in shades of orange &amp; amber; amber color accentuates into summer &amp; the veins become more prominent; fall foliage is bright red &amp; orange; upright habit to 10' tall by 8' wide in 10 years; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native (Buchholz) Zones 5 - 8</i>			1g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Baton Rouge'</b> Coral Bark Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; inconspicuous red &amp; white flowers in spring; small winged samaras appear in late spring &amp; mature in fall; spring foliage has some red edging which disappears by summer when bright green takes over before turning bright golden-yellow with red edging in fall; winter bark is bright electric red on younger stems; upright habit to about 12' tall in 10 years; tolerates heat well (found in TX near Houston); locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; Japanese native; Zones 6 - 7</i>			5g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Bihou'</b> Beautiful Mountain Range Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; emerging spring foliage is light yellowish-green with a pink flush; summer foliage is medium green before transitioning to bright yellow or light orange in fall; in winter young branches turn shades of orange or pink &amp;/or gold; bushy upright habit when young to 7' tall by 3' wide in 10 years; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native (Yano) Zones 5 - 7</i>			5g

<b>Acer palmatum 'Shishigashira'</b> Lion's Head Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; crinkly green layered foliage all spring &amp; summer turns shades of gold &amp; crimson in fall; green bark; slow broadly upright to vase-shaped habit that will be as wide or wider than tall; natural bonsai look; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i>			5g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Skeeter's Broom'</b> Dwarf Columnar Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; bright red spring foliage turns darker red by early summer then mostly dark reddish-green before turning bright scarlet in fall; slow to moderate upright grower to about 6' high by 3' wide at maturity; witches broom from 'Bloodgood'; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native (Rodd) Zones 5 - 7</i>			7g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Summer Gold'</b> Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; bright yellow spring foliage turning soft light yellow-green by mid summer; seems to be most resistant yellow foliage cultivar to summer leaf scald; foliage turns orange in fall; upright habit to 12' at maturity; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native (Gilardelli) Zones 5 - 9</i>			1g

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<b>Acer palmatum 'Tsukasa Silhouette'</b> Columnar Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; inconspicuous red &amp; white flowers in spring; small winged samaras appear in late spring &amp; mature in fall; 5 to 7 lobed chartruese leaves appear in spring maturing to dark green by summer then turn vibrant shades of orange &amp; red in fall; narrow pyramidal habit to about 20' tall by 6' wide in 20 years; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil that's neutral to acidic; Japanese native (Tanaka) Zones 5 - 7</i>			1g 3g	
<b>Acer palmatum 'Twombly's Red Sentinel'</b> Columnar Red Japanese Maple <i>DECIDUOUS ORNAMENTAL TREE; this sport of 'Bloodgood' is more upright with slightly lighter burgundy foliage; it's a moderate grower which will mature about 20' with a spread of about 15'; foliage turns shades of crimson in fall; locate in full sun to partial shade &amp; well-drained moisture retentive organic soil; afternoon shade helps retain best foliage colors; Japanese native; Zones 5 - 7</i>			1g 7g
