Picea abies Norway Spruce <i>EVERGREEN CONIFER; pyramidal habit to about 60' tall by 30' wide at maturity; dark green needles persist for several years; plants are lightly tipped for shape; loose branching; resists deer browse; locate in full sun to partial shade & well-drained neutral to acidic moisture retentive soils; native to northern Europe; Zones 3 - 7</i>		8 - 10' 10 - 12'	B&B B&B
